## Odessa Aquatic Center

The Odessa Aquatic Center at Dyer Park opens on Monday, May 30. The daily fee is \$5 for ages 3 and over. A season pass is \$90 for an individual. The family of four season pass is \$200 for four members, with \$30 for each additional person (family members must live in the same residence to qualify).

Pool hours are 1:00-6:00 pm Monday through Thursday, Saturday and Sunday, and 1:00-7:00 pm on Friday. Pool rental is available Monday through Friday from 7:15-9:15 pm and Saturday and Sunday from 6:15-8:15 pm or 8:30-10:30 pm. ## Trash Service – Bulk Item Pickup

Each residence within the city limits of Odessa is allowed **one free** bulk item pickup per month. To schedule a bulk pickup, please contact City Hall at 816-230-5577 or Republic at 660-429-1040 or email at [heartland@republicservices.com](mailto:heartland@republicservices.com).

### ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Furniture
- Microwaves
- Lawnmowers (empty of fuel and oil)
- Barbeque grills (without propane tanks)
- Carpeting up to 4 foot long rolls that are securely tied, weighing less than 40 lbs. Two rolls count as one item.
- Mattresses and box springs
- Wood must be bundled in 4 foot lengths, with each bundle weighing less than 40 lbs.
- Miscellaneous debris must be in bags that are no bigger than 39 gallons and weigh no more than 40 lbs. Two bags equal one item.

### NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Appliances
- Water Heaters
- Hazardous waste (flammable, corrosive, explosive, etc)
- Automotive batteries
- Tires
- Compressed Gas Cylinders
- Riding Lawnmowers
- Glass panels exceeding 4 feet
- Yard waste, brush, tree limbs
- Rocks, bricks, or concrete
- Latex or oil-based paint
- Fertilizer, pesticides, solvent
- Construction material larger than 4x4, roofing materials, loose flooring materials, or railroad ties.
- Liquid waste

For hazardous waste, you may contact Jan Vahrenberg in Mayview at 816-263-1072. She allows most hazardous waste but no tires. Drop offs are welcome every third Saturday of the month between 1:00-4:00 pm in downtown Mayview on E Highway across from Michelle's Restaurant.
